Dear Parents and Carers,

I have to start this e-mail by saying a massive thank you to you all for your support and kindness over the last term. I know that when we began the year in September, I was feeling very positive, following the vaccination programme, that we would be able to enjoy a more "normal" term than Autumn 2020. As you all know, that hasn't been the case and in fact, it has been harder than before in terms of covering staff absence whilst still keeping the school open. Two groups of children have been involved in a "circuit breaker" situation where they have had to go home to undertake PCR testing with Year 1/2 having to repeat this again over Thursday and Friday this week. Throughout this time, you have been understanding of the challenges we have faced, wearing masks on the playground, keeping siblings at home when there has been COVID in your household and understanding when our processes haven't been as slick as they may usually be. Radstock Primary is a community and we really couldn't do it without you, so thank you very much.

COVID-19 reminders



All parents

Should your child suffer with 1 or more COVID-19 symptoms (a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to their sense of taste or smell) and receive a POSITIVE COVID-19 test result from today onwards, please contact covid@radstock.wokingham.sch.uk. This will be checked regularly during the Christmas period.

If cases occur initially after term ends, close contacts within a class or year group will be asked to lateral flow test daily for the first 7 days and will be informed by email. This is a change to previous practice because of the change to government guidance. All individuals who have not tested positive for COVID-

19 within the last 90 days and are over 5 years old are asked by Public Health to test to protect the rest of your family as well as the NHS, given the current situation with community transmission. Please see advice here for more information.

Please inform us of the following information: your child's name and class; the first date of their symptoms; the date of their POSITIVE test result and their last date in school. We do not need to know about family members who test positive during this time.

We are required to inform Wokingham Borough Council of all positive cases in our pupils, so please continue to inform us via our COVID inbox should they test positive, even later in the holiday.

Thank you for your support.

Please can I remind you that after Christmas when we return, all parents on the playground at drop off and collection should be wearing a mask unless medically exempt. With the Omicron variant, this is now more important than ever.

Please also make sure you are socially distant from each other when entering and exiting the site - there have been groups of people chatting as they leave which prevents others from being safe. Please move well away from the school site before gathering to talk and always remain at least 2 metres apart from each other.

I have been asked to send out COVID guidance from the local authority and it accompanies this message.

As far as I am aware, school will be returning as planned after Christmas. As always, we will be in touch should the situation change!
